

# SIGHTS TO EXPLORE

- Royal Palace** Visit the Royal Palace and admire the scenic architecture in Stockholm's 'Old Town'.
- Grand Hôtel** Visit the National Museum and travel across to Skeppsholmen, home of the Museum of Modern Art with one of the world's finest collections of 20th and 21st century artworks.
- Royal Sightseeing - Hop on Hop off by boat** Continue your journey along Stockholm's waterways with Hop on Hop off by boat.
- Vasa Museum** Visit the 17th century Vasa ship, Nordiska Museum and Junibacken Children's Museum - home of Astrid Lindgren's fairytale characters.
- Gröna Lund & Skansen** Experience Skansen, the world's oldest openair museum and zoo. Also worth a visit are Gröna Lund amusement park and Liljevalchs Art Venue.
- Nordiska Museum** Visit the Nordiska Museum, Junibacken; home of Astrid Lindgren's famous characters, and the amazing Vasa ship from the 17th century.
- 6a 6b 6c Frihamnen (620, 638, 634 & 650)** Cruise ships to Riga, Tallin & Finland.
- Karlaplan** Take a walk in the heart of Östermalm and visit the National Historical Museum featuring exhibitions on the Vikings.
- Stureplan** The heart of Stockholm's nightlife district. Here you can find the Sture Gallerian shopping mall and lots of good restaurants.
- Concert Hall** Experience the marketplace of Hötorget, get some shopping done in Drottninggatan, or enjoy a concert in the Concert Hall.
- Casino Cosmopol** Feeling lucky? This is Stockholm's only casino.
- City Hall** The City Hall attracts over 400,000 visitors a year. It is well known for its unique art treasures and also hosts the annual Nobel Prize Banquet.
- Central Station** Only a short walk from the famous Icebar in the Nordic Sea Hotel. Inside the Central Station you also find Stockholm Info Tourist Information.
- Gallerian** Visit the cultural events and exhibitions at The House of Culture or visit one of the many shopping malls in the area. Inside the Gallerian Shopping Mall you can find Stockholm Info.
- Gustav Adolfs Torg** Visit the beautiful Royal Opera House or just enjoy spending some time in the public square, which is technically the most central point of Stockholm.
- Old Town** Experience the picturesque 'Old Town' with its many shops, cafés and restaurants.
- Slussen (The Lock)** Take a walk down Götgatan and experience this trendy and vibrant district in the south of Stockholm.
- Fjällgatan - Panoramic view** Probably one of the most spectacular views in Stockholm.
- Viking Line & Cruise Line Terminal** Ferries to Helsinki.
- Skeppsbron** With beautiful views of central Stockholm, you can take a walk along Strömkajen or around the bustling streets of the 'Old Town'.
