- Cunard purchased more tickets on Concorde than any other.





Shuttle bus service.

There will be a continuous shuttle bus transfer service from Queen Victoria to Barcelona city centre. The drop off point is at the World Trade Centre. The first bus will depart at 8.00am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 15 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Victoria will be at 6.00pm. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. There is no need to purchase tickets in advance as we will scan your Guest ID card when boarding. A maximum of two journeys will be charged per day; each additional journey for today will be free of charge. This service is chargeable for guests who booked Cunard Early Saver and Saver Fares, Adult Single \$6,00 per person (one way) and \$3.00 per child (one way). Guests who booked other fare types will not be charged for this shuttle bus transfer service. We anticipate queues during peak times, so some guests may wish to consider using a local taxi to avoid waiting.

The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

Smoking policy.

Designated areas of the open deck where smoking is permitted is on the starboard side of decks 3 and 10 only, please use the ashtrays that are provided in these areas. Electronic cigarettes and vaporising devices, including those which do not emit smoke, are permitted in designated areas of the open deck only.
