Nautical fact of the day.

"The Nautical Chart"

Two types of charts are produced for use navigationally. Mercator charts (on which rhumb line courses appear as straight lines) and gnomonic charts (on which great circles appear as straight lines). In general navigation terms, ships steaming from one place to another across the sea steer rhumb line courses, with gnomonic charts used only when wireless and direction-finding bearing (which travel in great circles) need to be plotted.





Palma de Mallorca sightseeing hop on, hop off bus.

You can purchase tickets for the Palma de Mallorca City Sightseeing hop on, hop off bus tour at the Tour Office. The Tour Office will be open from 8.00am to 10.00am and from 4.00pm to 7.00pm on deck 1, midships in the Grand Lobby.

Shuttle bus service.

There will be a continuous shuttle bus transfer service from Queen Victoria to Palma town centre. Drop off point is by the Seu Cathedral. The first bus will depart at 8.30am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 15 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Victoria will be at 9.00pm. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. There is no need to purchase tickets in advance, we will scan your Guest ID card when boarding. A maximum of two journeys will be charged per day; each additional journey for today will be free of charge. This service is chargeable for guests who booked Cunard Early Saver and Saver Fares. Adult Single \$8.00 per person (one way) and \$4.00 per child (one way). Guests who booked other fare types will not be charged for this shuttle bus transfer service. We anticipate queues during peak times, and so some guests may wish to consider using a local taxi to avoid waiting.

Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

Jogging and power walking

For those guests wishing to power-walk or jog, one lap around the outside Promenade on deck 3 equals 1/3 of a mile. The track is protected from the weather at the forward end. Please only power-walk and jog on deck 3 after 7.00am and before 8.00pm, as it disturbs guests who might be sleeping in the staterooms/suites below. All guests are kindly asked to walk counter clockwise.
