## TRANSPORT

**Public Transport:** S-Trains, Metro, and busses. Joint-ticket system for all three options. A 2-zone city ticket costs DKK 24, valid for 60 minutes. If you need to get to and from the cruise terminals by public transportation, then catch bus number 26.  
**Tickets:** Tickets bought on the bus: DKK Cash only. Tickets can be bought at DSB ticket machines found at all S-train and Metro stations, almost any credit card accepted. Many S-train stations have 7-eleven kiosks, purchase your ticket here, credit cards accepted. Note: Not Maestro Card. Please beware: Fines of DKK 750 if no ticket.  
**Other Options:** Taxis, Bike Taxis, Rental Bikes, Sightseeing Busses Hop-On/Off, Canal Tours. Normal taxi start tariff: DKK 36 and DKK 12 per km driven. Or buy a Copenhagen Card: free entrance to 72 museums and attractions and free transport. Choose between 24/48/72/120 hour options. Buy at S-Train stations, Airport, Central Station or Tourist Office, opposite of Tivoli.
